## **Formats**

15 a Side - 8 Teams – 2 Groups of 4, Top 2 from each group to content Semi Finals of Cup with Bottom 2 competing in the Shield Semi Finals

2 Points for a Win, 1 for a Draw

Two substitutes shall be introduced 8 minutes into the first half and 4 minutes into the second half. The referee will stop play at this point. Four substitutions minimum to be made during a game.

If Teams finish level on points:

A) The winner of the original game between those two teams shall be ranked higher. b) If that game ended in a draw, the team with the overall aggregate lowest score conceded shall be ranked higher. c) If the aggregate lowest score conceded is equal, the ranking will be decided by a free taking competition. d) Five frees will be taken.

Group Games x 3, 12min halves with short break

## **Requirements:**

26 Players only to be toggled

Umpire and Linesman to be provided for each game by each club

Food to be provided by each club to their players

Max 4 Team Mentors, one of whom should have a First Aid Bag

If there is a clash of colours, a toss of coin to decide which team to change so please ensure to bring alternative coloured jerseys or bibs to facilitate this.

## **Warm Ups**

Warm Ups should be done in wall ball area & grass area behind dressing rooms

## **Club Areas**

Cappawhite GAA contact can direct teams to area between pitch 1 & 2 behind advertising hoarding should any club wish to set up an area/ gazebo for their players and gear etc.

## **Dressing Rooms**

Cappawhite GAA will allocate 8 dressing rooms across the facilities, with thanks to our Community Council for the use of their dressing rooms. These rooms will be assigned at random and each will be signed with the relevant club.

A Cappawhite club contact will be there on arrival to assist and direct you to the appropriate facilities. We ask that all players respect the facilities and that players are supervised at all times and that facilities are left in the condition that they were provided.

## **Medical**

Cappawhite GAA will provide access to a Physiotherapist and First Aider for the day. The position of the physio will be communicated on arrival. Paddy Julian MISCP will be available throughout the day.

There is an AED located on the side entrance of the community centre close to the entrance of the GAA pitch.

The code is written on the cabinet.

## **Toilet Facilities**

Toilets are located close to the dressing rooms at the top on the pitch and there are also toilets including an accessible toilet in the community centre.

## **Photographer**

We will have a photographer on the facilities during the day taking photos which will be uploaded to our club social media. Please inform us in advance if you have any children who have communicated that they do not permit their photo to be taken.

## **Parking**

We have parking facilities at the pitch – at the car park which is accessible from the Tipperary Road side of the venue, there will be some parking also available via a gate to the bottom of the pitches. A steward will be there to assist and direct on the day. Please ensure to keep all medical access areas clear.

Please ensure also to park in a way which will not disrupt regular traffic on the day.

Buses will be directed by our steward to park across the road from the community resource centre.

## **Food & Drink**

Facilities for Eating - Cappawhite GAA will provide access to a large hall where players and mentors can sit down inside to eat their food

We will have tea & coffee and a selection of sandwiches/ buns etc available in the community hall from 10 to 2.

There are 2 shops in Cappawhite, Costello's Shop is a minutes walk from the grounds and Centra is a 5 min walk from the grounds.

Costello's will be serving hot food from 8:30- 3:30. Phone 062- 75182 for pre orders.

Ryan's Centra will have a hot & cold food deli open until 3pm and the shop will open until 20:30. Phone 062- 75122 for pre orders

Nico's Takeaway will be open from 3pm.

Drinking water is available from the tap located between the 2 pitches and we would encourage all teams to use reusable bottles.

## Lotto

Cappa Lotto which funds both the development to our GAA Club and our Community Council will be on the facilities during the day and we would ask for support if possible. The jackpot stands at the Maximum of €23,000 so well worth a chance! Cash or SumUp will be on hand for tasking any payments. Best of luck!
